A. Drucker Joint JD/MBA Program

Southwestern Law School and the Drucker Graduate School of Management, part of Claremont Graduate University (CGU) at the Claremont Colleges, offer dual-degree programs to expand students' educational and career options. Students at Southwestern and the Drucker School can earn a J.D. and Master of Business Administration (MBA).

Law students who wish to earn the JD/MBA degree are eBusiness Administration degrees. The remaining units are earned at the respective institution.
