



Student's Right to Cancel and Tuition Refund Policy

Administrative policy approved July 22, 2022. Effective immediately.

Revision history: Formerly a part of the annually revised Student Handbook ; established as a standalone policy August 2022; revised in August 2023 and February 2024 to adjust to our new status as an approved entity with California's Bureau of Private Post secondary Education; revised in March 2024 to revise the time within which refunds are issued and add specific state information in an addendum.

Scheduled Review Date: June 2024 (Accounting and Financial Aid Office s)

A. Right to Cancel and Refund During the Cancellation Period

Students have the right to cancel their Enrollment Agreement with Southwestern Law School without any penalty or obligations through attendance at the first class session or the seventh day after signing the Enrollment Agreement, whichever is later (the "Cancellation Period").

A student that they no longer wish to attend Southwestern or be bound by the Enrollment Agreement. An incoming student who has not previously attended Southwestern must notify the Admissions Office (admissions@swlaw.edu
